Ascension of Jesus



This week we will celebrate the Feast of the Ascension.

According to the New Testament in the bible, Jesus met several times with his disciples during the 40 days after his resurrection (Easter Sunday) to instruct them on how to carry out his teachings. It is believed that on the 40th day he took them to the Mount of

Olives, where they watched as he ascended to heaven.

Ascension Thursday marks the end of the Easter season and occurs ten days before Pentecost, when the disciples received the Holy Spirit.

We might compare the Ascension to the passing of a baton from one runner to another in a relay race. On this day, just over 2000 years ago, Jesus passed the baton of his work to Peter, James and John. They, in turn, passed it on to the people who came after them. They, in turn, passed it on to us. And now it is our turn to pass it on to others. This week, let us all try to show our beauty and harmony so as to lead to a more peaceful world.

Tomorrow is National Sorry Day.

National Sorry Day is an Australia-wide observance held on May 26 each year.

This day gives people the chance to come

together and share the steps towards healing for the Stolen Generations, their families and communities. It is important for us to remember our history which will allow us to move forward in reconciliation with one another.

Reconciliation Week - May 27th - 3rd June

The theme for National Reconciliation Week in 2022 is "Be Brave- Make a Change"

A challenge to all Australians - individuals, families, communities, organisations and government - to Be Brave and tackle the unfinished business of reconciliation so we can Make Change for the benefit of all Australians. Last year, Reconciliation Australia encouraged all Australians to take action; not just in National Reconciliation Week but evey week of the year.

We saw unprecedented response to our suggested actions for everyday and for braver action. This year we are asking everyone to make change beginning with brave actions in their daily lives - where they live, work, play and socialise.

National Reconciliation Week - 27 May to 3 June - is a time for Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures and achievements and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. We all have a role to play when it comes to reconciliation, and in playing our part we collectively build relationships and communities that value Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, histories, cultures and futures.
