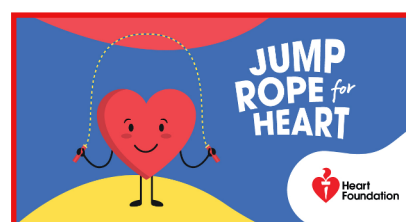

- Student/Teacher/Parent who can skip the longest without stopping

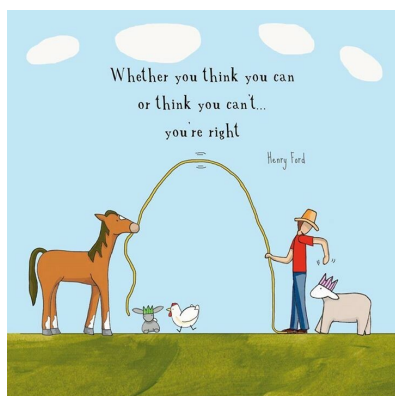

- *Set clear goals and strive to achieve them*



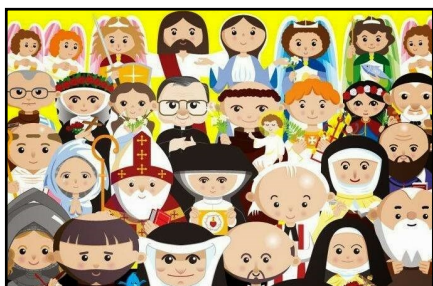
This week we will be focusing on inspiring those around us while also recognising the qualities of those who inspire us. Please let them know that they make a difference to you.
